## snock Hoppens

The animals have free range in the kitchen and have set about raiding the fridge. Piece by piece, they are gathering delicious snacks like watermelon, cake, and peppers into their hiding places. Who will fill their hiding place first?

1 Fridge gameboard in box bottom


5 Discs


60 Snacks


4 Puzzle boards


1 Die with Snack icons

Carefully remove all the Snacks from the Puzzle boards before your first game.
Don't throw away the Puzzle boards as you will need them to play the game!

## Game Setup



1. Place the Fridge (in the box bottom) in the middle of the play area.
2. Place Discs next to the Fridge: 3 Discs in a 2 player game, 4 Discs in a 3 player game, and 5 Discs in a 4 player game.
Set aside any remaining Discs as they will not be needed.
3. Take 1 Puzzle board each and place the die within easy reach of the players.
4. Place the Snacks nearby as a general supply.

## Game Play

Play is in clockwise order with the Start player determined by the player who most recently raided the fridge.

On your turn, hold the Disc's in your closed hand about 4 inches above the box and let them fall into the Fridge. If any Discs accidentally fall outside, gently toss them back in.

Important: Each Disc must be clearly assigned to a compartment in the Fridge. Multiple Discs may be in the same compartment. A If a Disc touches more than one compartment, you may move it into one of these compartments of your choice.


Now choose 1 Disc and perform that compartment's action.

## Actions



## LOOT

Your Puzzle board determines which Snacks you can Loot. If your selected Disc is in a compartment with 1 or 2 Snacks, take the corresponding Snack(s) from the general supply.

Now place each one in an open space on your Puzzle board.

Then remove your selected Disc from the box.


## MOUSE FOOD

If your selected Disc is in the compartment with the Mouse, then you get nothing because the little rodent has eaten it all! Remove the Disc from the box.


## SNACK BOX

If the selected Disc is in a compartment with a Snack Box, roll the Die to determine your action.

If the Die shows a Snack, you Loot 1 of that type from the general supply. If it shows the Mouse, you get nothing.

The third action on the Die is wild and allows you to take 1 Snack of your choice from the general supply.


## SPECIAL ACTION: BLENDER

Whenever you Loot a Snack and you don't have an open space for it on your Puzzle board, add it to your Blender instead. As soon as there are 3 Snacks in your Blender, you can exchange them for any 1 Snack of your choice. Return the 3 snacks from the Blender to the general supply and tale 1 Snack of your choice to place in your Puzzle board.

Remember to remove your selected Disc from the box at the end of your action. Now your opponents will take their turns to try to Loot something delicious from the Fridge. Beginning with the player to your left, each remaining player must also select 1 Disc and perform the corresponding action. Once everyone has chosen a disc, there will always be 1 Disc left in the box. Remove it without performing an action. Then the player to the left of the previous Start player begins the next round as Start player and takes all the Discs in their hand.

## Game End

As soon as any player has filled all the spaces in their Puzzle board, continue play to the end of the round so that each player has had their turn selecting a Disc. Then the game ends and everyone who has successfully completed their Puzzle board has successfully raided the Fridge.

If you want second helpings, play another game!
